CHAPTER 118  
Senate Bill No. 793  
Sex Discrimination—Educational Institutions—Regulations

An act to amend Section 232 of the Education Code, relating to education.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 793, Davis. Education: prohibition of sex discrimination.

Existing law requires the State Board of Education, the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, and the Trustees of the California State University, and authorizes the Regents of the University of California, to issue rules, regulations, or orders to implement specified provisions relating to the prohibition of discrimination on the basis of sex.

This bill would revise existing law by requiring the State Board of Education, the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, and the Trustees of the California State University, and authorizing the Regents of the University of California, to issue regulations pursuant to provisions of existing law commonly known as the Administrative Procedure Act to implement those provisions relating to the prohibition of discrimination on the basis of sex.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:  
CA EDUC § 232

SECTION 1. Section 232 of the Education Code is amended to read:

The State Board of Education, the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, and the Trustees of the California State University shall issue <<-\* \* \*->> regulations <<+PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.5 (COMMENCING WITH SECTION 11340) AND CHAPTER 5 (COMMENCING WITH SECTION 11500) OF DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 2 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT,+>> to implement the provisions of this chapter.

The Regents of the University of California may issue <<-\* \* \*->> regulations <<-\* \* \*->> to implement the provisions of this chapter. <<+ IF THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA CHOOSE TO ISSUE REGULATIONS IT MAY ISSUE THEM PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.5 (COMMENCING WITH SECTION 11340) AND CHAPTER 5 (COMMENCING WITH SECTION 11500) OF DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 2 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.+>>

Sec. 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that Section 264 of the Education Code, relative to the applicability of Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 200) of Part 1 of the Education Code to the University of California, apply to the section of the Education Code amended by this act.
